What is one step you can take this week in response to today's discussion?



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Week 2: APT REPLY

What is one thing you took from last week's discussion?

Talk about how you are doing with your next step from last week.

Read through Colossians chapter 4, focusing on verses 5-6.

Watch Video "Sharing Your Faith Naturally," Starting it around 24:17 and pausing it around 46:00. Saving the discussion about gospel bites for next week.

John said that we are all responsible to give an answer when asked about our faith. That we are called to speak up in these moments. What makes this challenging for you?

What do you think John meant by saying we should speak from worship when we speak up? What do you think this looks like practically?

We must also pay attention to our posture when we are sharing our faith. Why do you think it is hard to speak with grace to those whom we disagree? What can we do to season our answers with grace?

What is one step you can take out of our discussion this week?



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Week 3 - GOSPEL BITES:

What is one thing you took from last week's discussion?

Talk about how you are doing with your next step from last week.

Watch Video "Sharing Your Faith Naturally," Starting it around 46:00 and continuing through the end of the video.

After watching John give gospel bites as a response to a few possible questions, how effective do you feel he was? What made him effective or ineffective?

Do you think you could share gospel bites like he did? Why or why not?

Jeff shared that in order to do this well we must know the gospel stories well. What feelings arise in you as you think about this?

What could you do this week in order to grow in your ability to share gospel bites?
