SERMON DISCUSSION GUIDE

Welcome to the eighth and final week of our series, **MAKE IT REAL**. This week, we look at James's teaching about how our faith can help us endure in challenging times.

ICEBREAKER

What is your favorite season, and why?

THIS WEEK'S TEXT

Have someone read James 5:7-20 aloud.

What recurring themes or images do you notice in this passage?

What insights do we gain about the early Christian community's challenges, values and practices through these themes and images?

What questions does this passage raise for you?

THIS WEEK'S SERMON

Pastor Aaron Buer taught us that real faith helps us endure challenging times. As a group, recall some of the sermon's big ideas or main points.

How do people in our culture often respond to challenges or hardships?

Reflecting on the analogy of a farmer patiently waiting for the harvest, in what areas of your life do you feel like you're in a season of waiting or endurance?

James encourages us to focus on the harvest and "see the gift of the rain" during difficult times. What are practical ways we can maintain this long-term perspective and see God's provision in our adversity or pain?

Share about a recent experience in which you saw God's provision in the midst of a challenging situation. How did that affect your perspective?

Do you find it easy to bring all of your emotions and situations to God, or do you tend to hold back in certain areas?

What is one way you can deepen your communication with God this week, in both good and hard times?

Practicing vulnerability and accountability with trusted Jesus followers helps us stand firm in our faith together. Discuss as a group how you are doing with being a safe space for vulnerability and accountability.

What is the next step your group could take to increase your vulnerability and accountability with each other? What might be preventing the next level of vulnerability and accountability?

Which part of the sermon encouraged or challenged you the most, and why?

WRAP UP

Reflect on the Make it Real sermon series. How has God grown or challenged your faith through the book of James? What is one area in which you would like to continue to grow during the coming months?
